- I.    Commission President Kravit called the meeting to order at 7:34 am
- II.   Upon a motion by Commissioner Wahl, seconded by Commissioner Fetherston, the Commission unanimously approved the minutes from the April 4, 2025 meeting.
- III.  Upon a motion by Commissioner Grossman, Seconded by Commissioner Wahl, unanimously carried, the commission convened into closed session at 7:35 am pursuant to State Statute 19.85(1)(c) for the purpose of considering employment, promotion, compensation, or performance evaluation data of any public employee over which the governmental body has jurisdiction or exercises responsibility. Specifically, the Police Commission will review applications and interview candidates for the position of Police Officer, pursuant to Wisconsin Statute 62.13(4) and Fox Point Village Code 112-16 (B).
- IV.  Upon a motion by Commissioner Grossman, Seconded by Commissioner Fetherston, unanimously carried, the commission convened into open session at 9:16 am. In open session, the commission unanimously approved a motion made to accept Ryan Bukouras, Owen Ellinger, and Justin Bryant as qualified for the position of Police Officer A conditional offer of employment can be made to all of the candidates subject to completion of a successful background investigation, psychological evaluation, and medical screening.
- V.   The police chief provided a brief update on the status of the department, staffing, and the 2024 annual report. Questions regarding the chief's report were answered and members were reminded that the report is available on the website as a PDF document for public review.
- VI.  Upon a motion that unanimously carried, the commission adjourned the meeting at 9:29 am.
