3. Recap of February 2026 Centennial Event

4. The Committee discussed the February Centennial event; overall it went well and heard from a lot of people that they enjoyed the tours and reception. Douglas will write up a short summary of the celebration to include in the book and we'll include some pictures from the event.

5. **Discussion and assignment of duties for June 13 Centennial Event** The Committee discussed the summer Centennial event to begin making preparations.

Tree Planting – Tree has been ordered, plaque arrived. The plan is to have an informal gathering at 12 noon within the boulevard of Community Place. Will also include the dedication of Douglas's Village President tree(s). We will not provide any sound system. Plan to print up small informational sheets with the tree information and significance of the tree placement.

Afternoon Gathering – Entertainment has been booked (band, petting zoo, inflatables, face painters and balloon twister). Discussed occurred on whether or not we need to add more entertainment. Ann will look into cost/availability of Betty Brinn, bubbles, hula hooper. So far 4 food/beverage vendors have confirmed, waiting on a few more. Will need booth for lemonade/tea drinks sponsored by Hollander Chocolate, Fox Point Foundation and possibly Waterstone Bank. There still may be some additional community groups that would like to set up at this event as well. Tables from inside the Pavilion can be used at the booths. Historical displays will be set up inside Longacre Pavilion. Jack, Emily and Ann will work on firming up details and the layout for this event

Advertising – Currently advertising in Nicolet Recgram, North Shore Living magazine, Village website and Facebook. The group agreed to send out a small postcard mailer to announce the event to the residents. Jack and Emily will coordinate. Jack is in discussions with "What's Brewing" to see if they are interested in doing any features on Fox Point.

Run/Walk – Emily and Molly Rittberg have been working with Village/PD on route logistics. Douglas has agreed to do voice recordings of the historical sites so they can be posted with a QR code on a sign at each of the sites. Jack will coordinate with Douglas.

Volunteers – Will need a number of volunteers throughout the day. Emily will start working on an online signup.

6. Discussion of Fall Centennial Event

The Committee discussed ideas for the Fall Centennial event. So far Chipstone has agreed to provide 4-5 tours of 12 people max. Also proposed an outdoor gathering on Chipstone property. The group discussed other ideas like having a picnic (everyone brings their own picnic) at Chipstone, have the book release at this event, provide light refreshments and music, have Chipstone show their videos to showcase their collection (possibly on an outdoor screen), provide window clings of when residents' homes were built, and/or provide a pamphlet of Fox Point architects and unique homes (all information is within the book). Emily and Douglas will meet again with Chipstone to see if a date can be decided on. Avoid September 19 as that's the FPF picnic.
